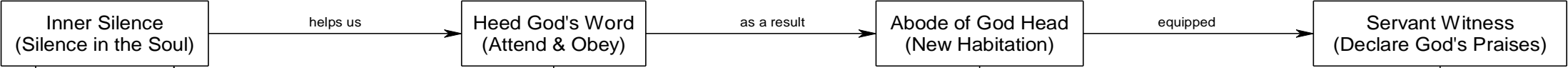


# Conditions for Receiving, (John 4:14), and Sharing, (Luke 6:38), the Knowledge of God (Isaiah 43:10)

1. "I have given them **thy word...**" (John 17:14)! "My child, **pay attention** to what I say. Listen to **My words**. Never let them get away from you. **Remember them and keep them** in your heart. They will **give life and health** to anyone who **understands them**" (Prov 4:20-22, GNT; Deut 32:46-47). "...The word of God is living and powerful, ...piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, ...and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart" (Heb 4:12, NKJV). "...The word of God... effectively works in you who believe" (1 Thes 2:13, NKJV).

2. Your memory aid is **U-PARK**. Understand, pay attention to, remember, and keep God's Word in your mind! Seems simple enough, but how do we consistently remember and keep God's word in our mind? The answer to the question comes from the chart below. Follow along as we navigate from 3 to 4.

Definitions:
